



German Gliding Championships in the 15m, 18m and Open Classes Held at Lüsse Airfield

COMPETITION ANNOUNCEMENT

1. Goals of the Championships

- 1.1 Select the German gliding champions in the 15m, 18m and Open classes.
- 1.2 Build the national teams for the upcoming European and world gliding championships in the FAI classes.
- 1.3 Promote cross country gliding. The competition is sanctioned by the IGC. The results will be included in the Official IGC Ranking List.
- 1.4 Foster the interest for gliding, especially among young people. Promote friendship among pilots and crews across international borders.

2. Organization

The championships are organized by the DAeC – Federal Gliding Commission and hosted by the FCC Berlin e.V. at the Lüsse airfield / Berlin.

3. Venue and Schedule

** In case one or more classes have not achieved 4 valid competition days on Wed 13.07.2011, an additional competition day will be set on Thu 14.07.2011 for all classes. In*

this case the closing ceremony and prize giving will take place in the evening of Thu 14.07.2011.

Participation in the opening ceremony, opening and safety briefings, daily briefings and closing ceremony and prize giving is mandatory for all pilots.

4. Fundamentals, Rules and Regulations

- 4.1 All legal requirements and all air-traffic laws pertinent to the championships as well as the statute of DAeC and the S.B.O.
- 4.2 The FAI Sporting Code Section 3 – Gliding together with Annex A.
- 4.3 The “Wettbewerbsordnung für Segelflugmeisterschaften” des DAeC (SWO) in its latest form (expected May 2011, see www.daec.de/se) together with the following amendments:
 - 4.3.1 Places left free by pilots who do not exercise their qualification rights are assigned according to the rules of the Federal Gliding Commission.
 - 4.3.2 In addition to the pilots who have qualified for participation in the national championships, a number of international guest pilots will be invited to join the competition. The scoring system will not distinguish between qualified pilots and guest pilots. However, guest pilots are not entitled to become “Deutscher Meister”.
 - 4.3.3 Pilots are responsible for the complete documentation of their competition flights through a valid GNSS flight recorder. Valid flight recorders are flight recorders which have been approved by IGC before 31.3.2011. Pilots are required to provide the type of their primary and backup flight recorder at registration time. They may also be required to provide the software and hardware needed to download valid IGC files from their flight recorders.
 - 4.3.4 Competition flights are started/finished by crossing a start/finish line (see SWO 9.4.2.2 and 9.7.1).
 - 4.3.5 Entering forbidden airspace will be penalized according to SWO, 10.
 - 4.3.7 Motor gliders shall be equipped with flight recorders with integrated Environmental Noise Level (ENL) systems according to Sporting Code 3.4.8.
 - 4.3.6 Launch will take place either via aerotow or self-launch.
 - 4.3.9 Eventual changes of the actual SWO and/or resolutions of the Federal Gliding Commission which are relevant for the championships will be announced at the latest at the opening and safety briefings.
- 4.4 This announcement and eventual amendments of the organizer.
- 4.5 The Local Rules as issued by the host.
- 4.6 The resolutions of the directors at the opening and safety briefing – valid during the whole competition. The resolutions of the directors at the daily briefings.
- 4.7 Anti-doping rules and procedures are implemented according to the current anti-doping regulations of the DAeC or FAI, to the documents enclosed with this announcement and thereafter according to the national anti-doping code or/and World Anti-Doping Code. De-

5. Class Definitions, Gliders and Equipment

- 5.1 The 15m class is defined according to SWO 3.1.3.
- 5.2 The 18m class is defined according to SWO 3.1.2.
- 5.3 The Open class is defined according to SWO 3.1.1.
- 5.4 As far as gliders and equipment are concerned, we draw your attention to SWO 4.2: “the pilot is solely responsible for the safety of the glider, for the provision of the documents required by air-traffic laws and regulations and for compliance with the pertinent class definition”.

6. Participants

- 6.1 A valid FAI sporting license is not required. Participants shall have their national membership confirmed by their respective national association via registration form. The qualification of invited international guest pilots will be assessed with the registration.
- 6.2 Participants who have not yet attained 18 years of age are required to have their registration forms signed by themselves and by their legal representatives.
- 6.3 The total number of participants is about 120 with at most 45 participants per class.
- 6.4 Participation is regulated by SWO qualification rules. A list of the pilots qualified for participation in the championships is published on the DAeC website www.daec.de/se.
- 6.5 Irrespective of any provisions in the Sporting Code, SWO, competition announcement (this document) and of resolutions of the competition directors and jury, the pilot remains solely responsible for complying with legal requirements and with air traffic law.

7. Registration

- 7.1 Registration deadline is the 31.03.2011 (date stamp).
- 7.2 Participants are requested to register with the enclosed registration forms.
- 7.3 Conditional registrations are not accepted.
- 7.4 Registrations are to be sent to the “DAeC, BundeskommissionSegelflug”
- 7.5 Incomplete registrations are not accepted.
- 7.6 Registrations become valid after the payment of the registration fee.
- 7.7 International participants apply to the FAI Anti-Doping Rules and Procedures.
- 7.8 *Only for qualified German participants:* The regional DAeC associations are responsible for sending the competition announcement (this document) to the pilots qualified for participation in the championships in due time. They are also responsible for checking the com-

pleteness of registrations, confirming receipt and for timely forwarding registrations to the host.

- 7.9 *Only for qualified German participants:* In case places are not taken up (by pilots who do not exercise their qualification rights), pilots with standby qualification will be informed by the office of the Federal Gliding Commission according to the SWO rules at least seven days before the beginning of the championships.

8. Registration Fee

- 8.1 The registration fee is EUR 300.
- 8.2 For participants below 18 years of age, students, trainees, participants under military or civil duty, the registration fee is EUR 200. Valid proof must be sent together with the registration form.
- 8.3 With the registration, pilots with regular qualification (not standby) are required to transfer the registration fee to the following FCC Berlin e.V. account:

11. Liability and Legal Proceedings

The competitor / responsible pilot declares with the delivery of the entry form, that he/she - except in cases of intent or gross negligence – irrevocably indemnifies the national and the local organisers, as well as their executive bodies and agents from any claim the competitor/responsible pilot, his/her heirs or estate may have for damages or arising out of any injury to himself/herself or caused by himself/herself or his/her death as a result of competing in the contest. This indemnification does not apply so far and for the amount, as an insurer acknowledges and pays for a claim.

Furthermore, the competitor declares for himself/herself and for his/her crew, that they agree to and accept the rules of the invitation in all respects.

If the competitor is participating in the contest with a glider which is not his/her own one, the owner of the glider declares, that he/she accepts the limitation of liability regarding claims for damages of his/her glider. Minors need the signature of their legal representative. Legal proceedings are excluded.
